Annual - a plant that completes its life cycle (germination, flowering, seeding, dying) in one growing season. Breaking bud - the stage of growth when a bud bursts through the protective bud scales. Broadcast sowing - scattering seeds evenly over the ground rather than in furrows or drills. Contact weedkiller - a weedkiller that kills by direct contact.

As a guide, 3L approximates to a child's beach bucket; 12L to a domestic bucket; 85L to a laundry basket. 150-200cm; 300-350cm etc. – These height categories refer to the height of the plant on purchase in centimetres.
