Constitutional Law: Power, Liberty, Equality presents most of the constitutional law cases generally considered canonical and, with one important exception, follows the tried and true organizational means widely used in constitutional law texts of dividing chapters and sections along subject matter lines such as the Commerce Clause, equal protection, freedom of expression, and so on.
