The .450 brass cartridge replaced the separate cartridges and percussion caps of the earlier Adams Model of 1866. The Adams MkI had been Britain's first self contained centre-fire revolver, however it was the MkIII which was the most widely issued, seeing service all over the world. The MkIII was designed by John Adams of the London Armoury Company, Adams produced the British Army's side arms from the 1850s through to 1880 when Enfield took over, producing the Enfield MkI.

This made it possible to fire the gun much more rapidly than contemporary single-action revolvers, such as the Colt, which had to be cocked before each shot. Deane and Adams' revolver was shown at the Great Exhibition of 1851, and subsequently approved by the British Army's Small Arms Committee in addition to being adopted by the East India Company for use by their cavalry.
