Their son grew up to be a man with his own larger-than-life statue in a building that bears his family's name on a campus once kept afloat by the selling of 272 enslaved Black people. This is a great American story, and John Thompson's experience sheds light on many of the issues rolling our nation. In these pages, he proves himself to be the elder statesman whose final words college basketball and the country need to hear.
